Former Tangrong Brick Kiln

Formerly known as the Samejima Tile Kiln Factory, which was established in 1899, it retains two towering chimneys, one Hoffmann kiln, three down-draft kilns, one experimental kiln, one tunnel kiln, a Japanese-era brick office, and so on. Like a brick kiln museum, it witnessed the industrial and economic growth in the past century. The red brick structure and brick decora-

Kaohsiung Zhongdou Wetlands Park

Stretching approximately 2.5 kilometers and covering an area of over 7000 square meters, the park contains wooden pavilions, suspension bridges, and tide observation platforms; it is filled with rustic charms in its simplicity. The multiple layered forests' imitation of nature provides a sense of forest in the city. A variety of birds resting along the river bank can be seen. The mangroves and wetlands have restored the Love River to its former glory. The park won the 2012 "Global Award in Construction Excellence", and was given the name of "source of love" in Kaohsiung.

The New Hakka Cultural Museum

Adjacent to the Heart of Love River. Jinshi (Golden Lion) Lake Scenic Park

Jinshi (Golden Lion) Lake was originally called Dapi, but was renamed because it lies before Lion Mountain (Shishan), and the hook-shaped lake resembles a lion. The lake covers an area of approximately 11 hectares. A golden stone lion sits beside the lake, as well as a piazza corridor which circles the lake. Standing in it listening to the sounds of insects and birds, watching the beautiful rays of sunset reflected in the lake is an unforgettable experience, and there is also a new light bridge, which spans the lake from north to south like a rainbow, creating an alluring scene.

She Tzai Lin Pi Wetland Park

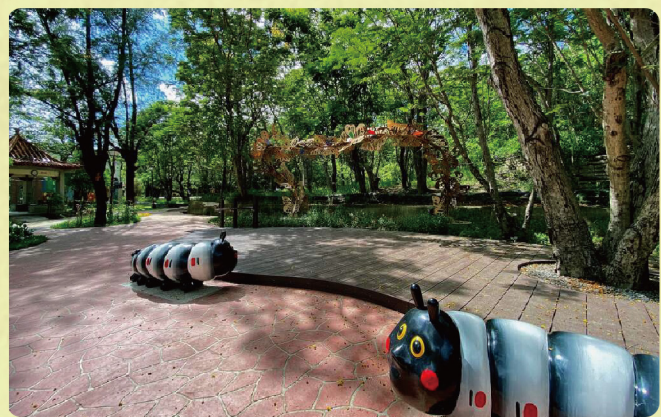
The Park provides the functions of flood detention, flood control, recreation and education. Its north side is an "ecological woods zone". Where densely growing mango trees act like the filter of the City, buffering the ecological environment from disturbances caused by the highway to the north. The "ecological maintenance zone" dredges and deepens the original terrain to form floating islands, where aquatic plants are planted to improve the water quality and attract waterfowls and other creatures. It is the background of Kaohsiung City.

Jinshi (Golden Lion) Butterfly Park

The Butterfly Park is situated on the eastern side of the Jinshi (Golden Lion) Lake Scenic Park, and its outdoor flowers, plants, and ponds attract wild butterflies. Its two large exhibition halls occupy approx 4462m2, and are filled with plants eaten by butterflies and nectar-producing plants. Murmuring streams flow past small bridges, allowing visitors to follow the wooden trail, which winds its way into a secret wonderland where butterflies dance, and also allows them to see the metamorphosis from pupae to butterflies.

Yu Huang Temple

Built in 1920, the Temple mainly enshrines Yu Huang (a.k.a. Jade Emperor). (Formerly a private temple of the Hsiu Family in Gushan, it was moved to the current location in 1961). Its appearance is grand and magnificent, and the Lingxiao Hall is entirely decorated with gold ornaments to accentuate the solemnity of the gods. The temple is a holy Taoist place that attracts a lot of believers.

The temple enshrines the Marshal of the Central Altar (a.k.a. Nezha). With Shishan behind it, the Temple faces the Jinshi Lake, a place endowed with the holy spirits of the universe. The three-story Temple is Northern Chinese style, the columns, bucks and arches are carved exquisitely and grandly. The bridge in front of the Temple is adorned with stone lions of various sizes, whose reflections on the Lake are divinely beautiful. It is the right place for both believers and tourists.

Sunfong (Sanfeng) Temple

Previously known as Sunfong (Sanfeng) Pavilion, Sunfong (Sanfeng) Temple now has over three hundred years of history and is the largest temple (dedicated to the Neza (also known as Marshal of the Central Altar 'Zhongtanyuanshui')) in Taiwan. It was moved to Hebei 2nd Road in 1971. This northern-style temple's architecture is elegant and splendid. The master painter Pan Lu-Shui crated the solemn and exquisite door gods through the use of flat-color painting skills. The temple's broad square lends it a certain majesty.

The two tall towers seem to guard the high-rise temples, and the roof is decorated with cutting and pasting ceramics and Koji pottery, making the temple grand and solemn. Its spring and autumn festivals represent how Hakka people sincerely admire and remember the Yiminye who sacrificed their lives to defend their hometowns, and symbolize the cohesion of Hakka spirit.

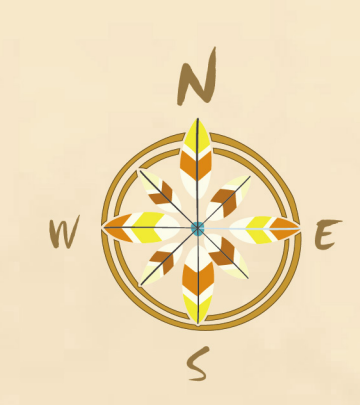
