Fongshan was the former administrative center of Kaonsiung County. As a traditional political center, it has many government agencies and historical sites. As time goes by, Fongshan today is a mix of tradition and modern. Not just full of monuments and temples, traditional stores and crafts such as blacksmith, Buddhist items shops, gold shops, rice shops and pastry shops also furnish the streets and lanes of Fongshan with a strong cultural heritage under its modern appearance.

Pingcheng Emplacement

Located right behind Caogong Temple, Pingcheng Emplacement is a 5 meter-tall square fort with a ladder



leading to the roof. The whole structure is very robust. No. 25-3, Caogong Rd.



Weiwuying Metro Park

Originally military ground, it transformed into a metro park after the army moved away. On the south side of the Park are the South Lake, Summer Promenade, Children's Playground, former recruit training plaza and Scenic Overlook built on the original central water tower. where one can overlook the entire area.



National Kaohsiung Center for the Arts (Weiwuying)

Inspired by the lush banyan trees in the Park, the Dutch architect Francine Houben created the largest venue for performing music and arts in East Asia. The outdoor theater is located on the south side of the main structure. With the sky as the curtain, the design breaks through the general ideas of performing spaces and created a non-typical theater space for everyone to enjoy a greater diversity of performances.

Fongshan, where R.O.C. Military Academy, the Army Infantry Training Commanding and Infantry School, and Chung Cheng Armed Forces Preparatory School are located, is a district of strategic importance for the army in Southern Taiwan. Opposite to R.O.C. Military Academy is Huangpu New Village, where Taiwan's first military dependents' village has been retained to this day. It is also one of the few former military housing communities during the Japanese colonial period in Taiwan that have been preserved. Today, many stores of young entrepreneurs and homestays have settled in here, bringing new life to the military dependents' village.

Kaohsiung Chengcing Lake Baseball Stadium



Kaohsiung Chengcing Lake Baseball Stadium is the most advanced and largest baseball stadium in Taiwan. In the preliminaries of Taiwan against USA in the 34th Baseball World Cup in 2001, 25,000 spectators thronged the stadium; it was the highest record in the history of baseball stadiums in Taiwan. It is also the major stadium of CPBL in Southern Taiwan.

Fongyi Academy had a total of 37 rooms when it was built in 1814. It originally enshrined Lord Wenchang, Lord Kuichang and Lord Cangsheng and is the largest existing historical tutoring academy in Taiwan. After the renovation in 2009, the chibi version of the statues was added. There are also exhibition spaces for displaying historical relics.






Fongshan Chenguang Taoist Temple

Two unique cultural relics can be seen inside the Temple: the "You are here" plaque and the "big abacus". "You are here" has the meaning that sooner or later everyone will have to report to the god Chenghuang; and the "big abacus" is a characterization of the calculation of the good and bad in one's life. The octagonal inner court painted with the Eight Immortals is very rare and has great historical and artistic values.



Fongshan Longshan Buddhist Temple With more than three hundred years of history, Fongshan

Longshan Buddhist Temple has been designated a Class 2 historical monument. Avalokitesvara is worshiped here. This Temple preserved the rich and complete traditional temple architecture and construction methods, and is the art palace of traditional artisans.

Fongshan Shuangcihting Temple

More than three hundred years ago, the god Avalokitesvara was invited from Putuoshan and was worshipped here as the main god. At the time the temple was called "Guanyinting" ("Temple of Avalokitesvara"). In 1753, the front hall was built; Tianshang Shengmu ("Holy Heavenly Mother") was invited from Quanzhou and was worshipped here. The believers felt mercy from both deities and thus changed the name to "Shuangcihthing" ("Temple of Two Mercifuls").

The Park focuses mainly on natural ecology education and is supplemented by sightseeing and recreation. With the recorded 89 species of birds, more than 270 species of insects, and more than 300 species of plants, the Park boasts rich and diverse ecological resources. Visitors can observe mallards, red-crowned waterfowls, small egrets, and so on in the wetland waters when walking along the boardwalks.

Chengcing Lake

The Park has winding paths with views, lush forests and beautiful scenery. The most famous eight scenic points in Chengcing Lake are: Kansu Plum Awakening in Spring, Bend Bridge Fishing for the Moon, Viewing Lotus from the Shore of the Willow, Viewing the Sea from the Hilltop, Sounds of Animals from Deep Forest, Pleasant Atmosphere of Lake, Hill Three Pavilions Tour, and Gold pours out from Pengdao. The simple and unsophisticated Chinese garden design merged with natural landscapes of mountains and rivers provides visitors with a relaxing and peaceful retreat to hearts.
