

Yong an District


Yong'an is a coastal fishing village located in the northwestern coastal area of Kaohsiung City, formerly known as "Wushulin." It features beautiful shorelines and rich natural ecological landscapes. Aquaculture is thriving here, especially for grouper, earning it the title "Hometown of Grouper" in Taiwan. The former Wushulin Salt Field has been transformed into an ecological conservation area, home to various bird species and mangroves, making it an ideal spot for birdwatching and ecological education. Local attractions include Yongxin Fishing Port and Diamond Sand Bay Park, both showcasing the charm of the sea. The annual "Yong'an Grouper Festival" draws many visitors to experience the local fishing culture and cuisine. With its blend of natural ecology and fishing industry, Yong'an is a perfect destination to explore the coastal beauty of southern Taiwan.

Yong'an Wetland

Once a former salt field in Wushulin, the area has been transformed into a vital ecological wetland featuring expansive mangrove forests and diverse waterbird habitats. It serves as an essential stopover for migratory birds traveling between north and south, especially during the autumn and winter months when rare species like black-faced spoonbills and egrets visit in large numbers. Visitors can stroll along wooden boardwalks to closely observe the rich ecology and intertidal landscapes. In addition to its ecological value, the wetland also plays a role in flood mitigation, making it an ideal location that integrates education, conservation, recreation, and natural heritage—reflecting the harmonious coexistence of nature and culture in Yong'an.

Yantian Painted Village

Located just across the road from Yong'an Wetland, this village preserves rows of traditional Minnan-style buildings. The rustic red-brick houses enhance the rural charm of the area. In collaboration with Tung Fang Design University, the Yong'an District Office initiated a community revitalization project based on the themes of "Sustainability, Local Identity, and Renewal." Through mural art, these old houses were transformed, breathing new life into the village. The murals incorporate elements such as salt workers, Taiwanese folk culture, and groupers—scenes unique to Yong'an. Visitors can experience the salt village's cultural past, where the charm of old times blends with blue skies and wetland landscapes, creating a nostalgic and artistic street scene.

Weixin Painted Village

Weixin Village is the most populous neighborhood in Yong'an District, where old and new houses coexist. The mural art decorating the building walls primarily features animals, such as a cute big dog, shark, and a groundhog eating peanuts. Using 3D painting techniques, these artworks create immersive scenes that interact with visitors, making them feel as if they've stepped into the paintings themselves.



Wulintou Trail

The Wulintou Trail offers a panoramic view of the power plant pier and the ring-shaped bay formed by numerous wave breakers, known locally as "Ring Bay." When the sunlight reflects off the ocean surface, it sparkles like diamonds—simply stunning. Following the trail down from the viewing platform, visitors can enjoy walking along the shore, splashing in the waves, or playing in the sand. At night, the spot transforms into a romantic setting, perfect for moon gazing and stargazing.

Wulintou Xuande Temple

The surrounding area still preserves traditional fish markets and fishing operations, offering visitors a vivid glimpse into marine life. Nanliao Seaside Light Corridor (Mituo Fishing Port Seaside Light Corridor)

Located next to Mituo Fishing Port, the Nanliao Seaside Light Corridor is a scenic walkway that combines seaside charm with leisure features. Along the path, visitors will find ocean-view platforms, a children's play area, a coastal avenue, a water-level walkway, seawall trails, a painted seawall, and 3D pavement art. It's the perfect place for a relaxing stroll, watching the sunset, and enjoying panoramic sea and sky views. At night, the corridor lights up the coast with a completely different ambiance, making it a favorite spot for locals and a new check-in destination for travelers. It's an ideal place to experience the coastal beauty of Mituo.

Tadishan Nature Park

Tadishan Nature Park is the coastal area of Kaohsiung where badland terrain comes closest to the sea. Its exposed ridgelines and barren gullies create a stark, unique landscape that blends geological features with natural ecology. Once a military base during the Japanese colonial period, it has since been transformed into a nature park. Walking along its trails reveals spectacular views of the Taiwan Strait and varying angles of the badlands terrain. At the summit, visitors will find a converted military bunker that now serves as a lookout, along with a 360-degree observation deck offering panoramic views of the coastline, birds in flight, and both Small and Big Gangshan mountains. Sunset is an especially popular time for photography. Along the way, you'll encounter coral reef rocks, dry streambeds, and wild plants, making this an excellent site for geological education and nature exploration, as well as a symbol of Mituo's natural and ecological value.

Wu Family Traditional **Courtyard House**

Among the traditional sanheyuan (three-section courtyard houses) in Mituo, the Wu Family Residence is the most iconic, known for its historical and cultural significance. This over-a-century-old residence features a "three-hall, two-courtyard" layout in a ∃-shaped (sun-shaped) configuration, typical of southern Taiwanese siheyuan architecture. The main hall is at the center, with rooms arranged by generation from left to right and front to back—divided into the front, middle, and rear sections, along with left and right side wings (hulong).
